Modified Field Requirements for Video Titling: Pop-up Fields

For individuals without access to a standard field, NATE is introducing pop-up fields for video titling. The field will not be required to have solid fences on four sides. Pop-up fields can be set up in a larger training field, an open space, or at a school or park.

These modifications are ONLY for video titling. They will not apply to live competition.

Per the [standard rules](#):

- The goal must have a solid back and sides.
- The handler area needs to be clearly shown with lines or cones.
- MFSL line must be marked on both sides with a cone, object or sign.

In addition:

- A fence or wall is best for the goal side of field, unless the dog reliably steers the ball into the goal.
- Field boundaries should be marked with cones or other objects. In Pre-Novice and Novice you may have a field that is 50'L X 35'W or the standard size of 75'L X 50'W. Intermediate through Masters must have a field that is 75'L X 50'W.
- Neither the ball nor the dog may travel outside of the boundaries during the course of play.
